

You are Dino-mite

You are Dino-mite is a design you can put anywhere. Embroider it on a tea towel, children's clothing or just frame it in a wood embroidery hoop. This design is a great way to show someone that you think that they are just Dino-mite.

Skill Level: Beginner

Janome Supplies:

- Janome embroidery machine
- Sewing machine
- A of F foot

Fabric and Notions:

- Embroidery thread, 4 colors
- Fat 1/8 of fabric
- Tare away stabilizer
- Tea towel
- Double sided fusible

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Embroidery Instructions:

1. Stitching Design

- Load the design onto your embroidery machine.
- Select OK to move to a ready-to-sew screen.
- Hoop the tare away stabilizer in a hoop that will fit the design.
- The hoop may vary depending on your machine.
- Thread the machine with the color of your choosing.
- Place the fabric in the center of your hoop.
- Baste the fabric in place.
- Push start.
- Change the thread color when the machine prompts you to do so.
- After the design has stitched out, take the hoop off of the machine and un-hoop the design.

2. Instructions:

- Tare away any excess stabilizer.
- Iron on the fusible to the back side of the embroidery.
- Trim the design 12" to 7" or to the desired size.
- Tare off the paper backing of fusible (if necessary).

3. Placement:

- Place the embroidery on the bottom of the towel.
- Make sure the sides are evenly spaced.
- Press the embroidery to adhere the adhesive to the towel.

4. Sewing:

- Thread the sewing machine with the thread color of your choosing. In this case, a light blue was used.
- Select a blanket stitch.
- Sew around the perimeter of the fabric.
- When you reach where you had started, secure and cut the threads.
- Change the thread color, in this case pink was used.
- Select the triple stitch.
- Increase stitch length to 5.0.
- Sew the triple stitch on the outside of the blanket stitch.
- Sew around the perimeter of the fabric.
- When you reach where you started, secure and cut the threads.

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
