

Double Friendship Star

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Block size: 12" x 12" (finished)

Skill level: Easy

These blocks are perfect for using Layer Cake (10" x 10") squares!
Cutting instructions are for making one block.

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUT
#1 Background	¼ yard or 2 – 10" squares	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 2 - 4 7/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally to yield 4 triangles. • Cut 4 - 4 1/2" squares.
#2 Large star points	1 – 10" square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 2 - 4 7/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally to yield 4 triangles.
#3 Small star points	1 – 10" square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 4 - 3 1/2" squares.
#4 Center square corners	1 – 10" square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 2 - 2 7/8" squares. Cut squares once diagonally to yield 4 triangles.
#5 Center square	1 – 10" square	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut 1 - 3 3/8" square.

CONSTRUCTION

(Note: RST = right sides together, HSTs = half-square triangles)

- Combine 4 fabric #1 and #2 triangles RST to make 4 HSTs, which should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 4 fabric #3 squares.
- Place fabric #3 squares RST on HSTs and stitch directly on the diagonal line.
- Trim 1/4" from the sewn line.
- Press seam allowance towards fabric #3.
- Squares should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
- Sew fabric #4 triangles on opposite sides of fabric #5 square and press seam allowance away from center.
- Add remaining #4 triangles.
- Assemble block as shown.
- Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished. Square-up if necessary.
