

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Hexie Mirror is a beginner-friendly introduction to our intermediate pattern, Church Window. The skills that you will practice with this construction help lay a foundation for methods used in Church Window. The Hexie Mirror cover quilt fabrics are AGF Gingerbread and White Linen with Mediterraneo for the binding.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- Skill Level: Advanced Beginner
- Check <https://www.loandbeholdstitchery.com/pages/pattern-corrections> for any updated corrections.
- All seams are a ¼”.
- A stitch length of 2.0 - 2.5 mm is recommended for piecing. A stitch length of 3.0 - 3.5 mm is recommend for quilting.
- All measurements listed in the pattern are unfinished.
- Diagrams are not to scale.
- This pattern assumes that your width of fabric (WOF) is 42”.
- You will be working with bias edges, starching fabrics before cutting is recommended.




FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

36" x 39½"	Fabric	Cut
Color 1	¾ yard	(4) 5" x WOF •(8) trapezoids •(4) Left Half Trapezoids •(4) Right Half Trapezoids
Color 2	¾ yard	(4) 5" x WOF •(8) trapezoids •(4) Left Half Trapezoids •(4) Right Half Trapezoids
Binding	¼ yard*	(4) 2¼" x WOF
Backing	1 ¼ yard	

*Exact amount needed

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


Trapezoid
Measurements
per WOF



Cut (4) 5" x WOF strips per color. Each WOF strip yields (2) trapezoids and (2) half trapezoids.

Note: You will be cutting at 45 degree angles. Use the 45 degree line on your ruler for accuracy or use the templates provided on pages 8-9.


*Pay careful attention to the direction of the angles in the cutting diagram to ensure the correct number of cuts for both right and left half trapezoids.



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Row A


1. To assemble Row A, sew (1) Color 1 left half trapezoid right sides together with (1) Color 2 trapezoid. For this and the remaining steps make sure there is a $\frac{1}{4}$ " overlap on both edges and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
2. Sew (1) Color 1 trapezoid right sides together with the unit from the previous step.
3. Sew (1) Color 2 left half trapezoid right sides together with the unit from the previous step.
4. Repeat steps 1 - 3 to make a total of (4) Row A units.
5. Press all seams open and trim dog ears.


- To assemble Row B, sew (1) Color 2 right half trapezoid right sides together with (1) Color 1 trapezoid. For this and the remaining steps make sure there is a $\frac{1}{4}$ " overlap on both edges and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
- Sew (1) Color 2 trapezoid right sides together with the unit from the previous step.
- Sew (1) Color 1 right half trapezoid right sides together with the unit from the previous step.
- Repeat steps 6 - 8 to make a total of (4) Row B units.
- Press all seams open and trim dog ears.


QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Assemble your quilt top in vertical rows and alternating Rows A and B as seen below. Align points and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Press all seams open.
- OPTIONAL step for a square quilt: This quilt finishes at $36" \times 39\frac{1}{2}"$ if this size is preferred skip to step 3. For a $36" \times 36"$ square quilt trim $1\frac{3}{4}"$ from both the top and bottom of the quilt top as shown in diagram.
- Baste, quilt, and bind as desired.








QUILTING IDEAS

This fun geometric quilting pattern is designed to compliment Hexie Mirror, is beginner friendly, and is created by repeating straight lines following the trapezoid edges. It may be helpful to mark your lines with a hera marker before sewing. Finish all the quilt lines going in one direction before starting on the opposite set.




Try out different design variations by increasing the number of quilted lines, varying the spacing between lines, or both!






AGF PURE Solids: Caviar & White Linen


