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
BEFORE YOU START

- WOF = Width of fabric. All pattern measurements assume Check cottonandjoy.com/pattern-corrections for any fabric to be 42" wide from selvage to selvage
- Seam Allowance = 1/4"
- Press all seams open unless otherwise stated.

MATERIALS	REQUIREMENT	CUTTING
CROWN - MAIN	1 Fat Eighth	1 21" x 6"
CROWN - LINING	1 Fat Eighth	1 21" x 6"
STABILIZER*	21" x 6" piece	-
RIBBON	30" to 40"	2 15" to 20"

^{*} Stabilizer: Use a medium weight iron-on fusible interfacing, such as *Heat N Bond*.

LEGEND



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- Fuse the fusible interfacing to the wrong side of the main fabric, then pin the lining fabric to the main fabric, right sides together. Fig 1
- 2. Mark the crown template five times and cut to create the crown shape. **Fig 2**
- 3. Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew around the edges, leaving gaps on either end. Backstitch at the beginning and end of your sewing to reinforce the stitches. **Fig 3**
- 4. Clip each corner and point and clip into the seam allowance at the inner points. **Fig 4**
- 5. Turn crown right side out through the gaps. Push out corners and points. Press crown.
- 6. Add ribbons to either end, making sure it's about 1" inside the crown. Topstitch the edges to secure the ribbon and close the gaps. **Fig 5**

OPTIONAL EMBELLISHMENTS

- Trace the star and number shapes onto felt and cut them out.
- Optional: If you'd like the embellishment to be interchangeable, sew a square of velcro to the center of the crown and to the back of the star shape. Fig 6
- Add the number to the felt star using your preferred method (fabric glue, hand stitch, or applique).
- Adhere the star/number unit to the crown using the velcro squares, or using glue or hand-stitching.


