

Halloween BOO Banner

Need a fun and fast Halloween project? This In-The-Hoop Boo Banner is the perfect addition to your decor!

Skill Level: Confident Beginner/Intermediate
Sewing Time: 1-2 Hours

Janome Supplies Required:

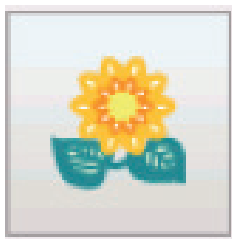
- Janome 500e Embroidery Machine
- SQ20b hoop
- Pumpkin design from web

Supplies + Fabric Required:

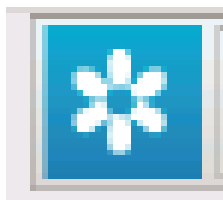
- Janome Embroidery Thread colors # F816, F828, F827, 235 & 002 (this is the color ordered used on the design.
- FIVE 12" X 12" squares of fabric
- FIVE 12" X 12" squares of stabilizer
- 8" strip of 60" wide Felt
- ¾ YD Paper backed Fusible Web
- 2 YD Cord or Ribbon
- Black pre wound bobbin

Sewing Instructions:

1. On the home screen of the 500e, select the Built-in Embroidery Designs Icon.



2. Press the design category key, to show the design lists by category.

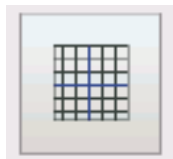
Press the previous/next page keys to page 3 of 3 and select Celebration Designs.



3. Select design # 3. Design will open up in the Ready to Sew screen. Select the Home key.



4. Select the Edit Key.



Select the Home Key, select Monogram key.



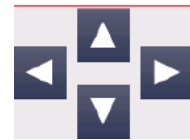
5. Select the Font selection key,



touch Gothic font, touch the Letter size key



(M medium letter is shown), and change to L, (Large)
6. Touch letter B , Touch OK, use the Jog Key to



move the letter to up to 2nd line on the grid and touch OK.

7. Hoop a piece of fabric with stabilizer and stitch out the first letter.

8. From the Ready to Sew Screen, touch the Home Key, Edit key, your design that was last stitched will be on the edit screen. Touch the letter and a green box will appear around it. Touch the delete key to delete the letter.



9. Select the letter O and repeat step 6 and 7 until you have all 3 letters stitched out.

10. To stitch out the pumpkin, download the design from the Janome Web site and transfer to a USB stick with the Embroidery Editor Software that came with your machine. Then put it into the USB port of the machine.

11. Touch the Open File Key, select USB Key.



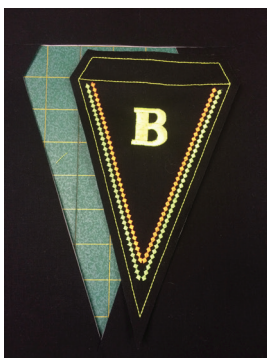

The design will be located in the *Embf* folder.

Select the design and it will appear on the edit screen.

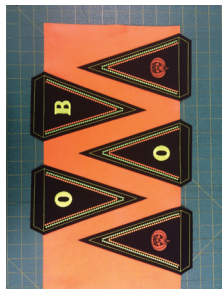
12. Move the design up to the same location of where you placed the letter, and stitch out the design.

13. Cut out the pennant design $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the outer seam stitching.



14. Fold back the top of the Pennant to the wrong side of the fabric and press on the folded line using a pressing cloth.

15. Fuse a piece of fusible web on the back side of the pennant. From the fold line down, cut along edge. Place the fused pieces on top of felt and fuse in place.



16. Cut out $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the black.



17. Press fold line. With matching thread stitch across the bottom of the folded edge. Insert cord. Hang up and enjoy!
