

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BEFORE YOU START

- **WOF** = Width of fabric. All pattern measurements assume fabric to be 42" wide from selvage to selvage
- Seam Allowance = 1/4"
- Press all seams open unless otherwise stated.

BACKGROUND	1 Fat Quarter	B1: 4 3½" x 3½" B2: 2 5" x 2" B3: 1 12½" x 4½"	B4: 1 12½" x 2" B5: 1 19" x 4¾" B6: 1 19" x 2½"
ORNAMENTS	4 Scraps, 3½" x 14" each	O1: 12 3½" x 3½" (4 from each scrap)	
ORNAMENT TOP	Scrap - 3½" x 2"	O2: 1 3½" x 2"	
BACKING and BATTING	24" x 24"		
PILLOW BACK	½ yard	P1: 1 19" x 14" P2: 1 19" x 11"	
BINDING	¼ yard	3 2½" x WOF	

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

ORNAMENT UNIT


- Layout the 12 O1 pieces into four rows of four pieces each.
- Sew together the rows from left to right, pressing the seams in the directions of the arrows. Fig 1
- Sew rows together, nesting seams as you go.
 Press seams open. Fig 2
- 4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong size of the B1 squares. Place a B1 square, right sides together, on a corner of the unit from Step 3. **Fig 3**
- Sew on the drawn line, then trim the corner leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Fig 4. Discard cut pieces and press seam.




- 6. Repeat with all B1 squares on remaining corners. **Fig 5**.
- 7. Sew a B2 piece to the O2 piece, followed by another B2 piece. **Fig 6**
- 8. Sew unit from Step 7 to the top of the unit from Step 6. Ornament Unit should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14". Fig 7

PILLOW TOP


- 9. Sew B5 piece to the top of the Ornament Unit. Press seam toward B5 piece. **Fig 8**
- 10. Sew B6 piece to the bottom of the Ornament Unit. Press seam toward B6 piece. **Fig 9**
- Sew B3 piece to the right of unit from Step 10, and a B4 piece to the left of the unit. Press seams towards B3 and B44 pieces. Your pillow top should measure 19" x 19". Fig 10





FINISH THE PILLOW

- Make a quilt sandwich by placing the backing fabric right side down, the batting on top, then the pillow top right side up.
- 2. Baste the layers together using your preferred method. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Hem one 19" side on the P1 piece by pressing the edge over to the wrong side of the panel by ¼". Press the folded edge over another ¼". Top stitch the hem in place by sewing ½" away from the folded edge of the hem. **Fig 11**
- 4. Repeat Step 4 with P2 piece.
- 5. Overlap the two panels on the backside of the pillow cover and baste the panels in place be sewing around the perimeter of the pillow 1/8-1/4" away from the edge. Fig 12
- 6. Sew binding strips together with diagonal seams. Trim excess, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams. **Fig 13**
- Once all binding strips are sewn together, fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press.
- 8. Sew binding to the pillow cover, lining up the raw edges. Fold binding over and machine or hand stitch to finish.
